

## How to know who is using my Edimax router.

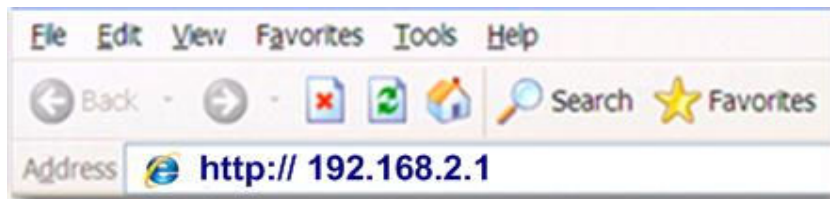

### Step by Step:

**Step 1** : Log on to the router's web page at <http://192.168.2.1>, and enter the user name, password. By default, the user name is " **admin** " ; while password is " **1234** " .



Step 2 : Click the “ Status Info”, “Status” and “Active DHCP Client” option.
